1 AN ACT Concerning Membership on the
2 Commission on Uniform State Laws.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 3 MRSA §241, first ¶, as amended by PL 1983, c.
7 812, §6, is further amended to read:

8 The Commission on Uniform State Laws, as estab-
9 lished by Title 5, section 12004, subsection 12,
10 shall consist of 3 members to be appointed for a term
11 of 4 years by the Governor. The commission shall al-
12 so consist of any residents who, because of long ser-
13 vice in the cause of state legislation, are elected
14 life members of the National Conference of State
15 Laws. The commission shall examine subjects on which
16 uniformity of legislation in the different states is

1 desirable; ascertain the best means to effect uni-
2 formity; cooperate with the commissioners of other
3 states in the consideration and drafting of uniform
4 acts for submission to the Legislatures of the sever-
5 al states; and prepare bills for introduction in the
6 Legislature.

7 STATEMENT OF FACT

8 This bill allows residents who have completed
9 long service in state legislation to become an
10 elected life member of the National Conference of
11 State Laws.

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
