COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 96, L.D. 243,
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Fees for Examination
and Licensure for Chiropractors."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. Allocation. The following funds are
allocated from other special revenue funds to carry
out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds an allocation section to re-
flect the increase in dedicated revenues which will
arise from an increase in registration fees. Even
though the original bill allows fees of up to \$100,
the allocation is based on testimony that for the 2
years in question the fee will only be raised from
\$40 to \$50.
