HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 96, L.D. 243,
Bill, "AN ACT to Increase the Fees for Examination
and Licensure for Chiropractors."

Amend the Bill by inserting before the statement
of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §553, as amended by PL 1983, c.
812, §199, is further amended to read:

§553. Fees; compensation and expenses

Any person to whom a certificate has been granted
under section 552 who wishes to renew that certifi-
cate shall, on or before the first day of June of
each year, pay to the secretary of the board a li-
cense renewal fee not in excess of \$50 \$100 as estab-
lished by the board. Upon payment of the fee that
person's certificate shall be renewed for one year.
In addition to the payment of such renewal fee, each
licensee so applying for his renewal certificate
shall furnish to the board satisfactory evidence that
he has attended one of 2 educational programs con-
ducted and supervised by the board in the year pre-
ceding. If such fee is not paid within 3 months af-
ter the date of notification by the secretary that
such fee is due, the certificate of the chiropractor
so failing to pay such fee shall be revoked and shall
be thereafter renewed by a majority vote of the board
and upon the payment of a fee of \$10 to the secretary
of said board. All fees received by the secretary and
not returned to the applicant shall be paid forthwith
to the Treasurer of State. The compensation of mem-
bers of the board shall be in accordance with the
provisions of Title 5, chapter 379. The secretary
shall be reimbursed for all expenditures for books,
stationery, postage and other necessary expenses au-
