Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Appropriation. The following funds are appropri-
ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes
of this Act.

16 These funds are necessary to continue currently
17 provided community mental retardation services.
18 Without this appropriation:

19 1. Eighty-four persons will lose developmental
20 day programing in fiscal year 1988 and 104 persons in
21 fiscal year 1989 will lose their programs;

22 2. Two hundred and forty-three thousand, one
23 hundred eighty-two dollars will not be available for
24 transportation in fiscal year 1988 and \$325,588 will
25 not be available in fiscal year 1989; and

26 3. Sixty-two thousand four hundred eleven dol-
27 lars will not be available for therapeutic services
28 in fiscal year 1988 and \$64,908 will not be available
29 for therapeutic services in fiscal year 1989.
