COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " \mathcal{H} " to H.P. 214, L.D. 266, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the State Antitrust Laws."

9 Amend the bill by inserting at the beginning of 10 the first line after the enacting clause (page 1, 11 line 5 in L.D.) the following: 'Sec. 1.'

12 Further amend the bill by inserting before the 13 statement of fact the following:

14 Application. This Act does not apply to 'Sec. 2. 15 any case commenced before the effective date of this Act, except that that part of this Act designated the 16 17 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 1104, subsection 4, does not apply to any case commenced be-fore the effective date of this Act unless the de-fendant establishes and the court determines, in light of all the circumstances, including the stage of litigation and the availability of alternative re-18 19 20 21 22 23 lief under any other law, that it would be inequitable not to apply that part of this Act to a pending 24 25 case.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment duplicates federal antitrust laws by adding an application clause to ensure that the provisions limiting the liability of political subdivisions for antitrust violations will not apply to any pending action, except in certain limited circumstances.
