AN ACT Authorizing a Study to Determine the Feasibility of Seat Belts in School Buses.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation for safety belt study. The Department of Transportation shall conduct a study of the use of seat belts in school buses. The Department of Educational and Cultural Services shall participate in the study of the volume of present school bus use; in the feasibility and desirability of using seat belts or other restraints in school buses; and in methods used in other states to meet safety needs for school busing. The department shall report the results of their studies to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature on or

1 before January 1, 1988, with recommendations and any 2 necessary legislation.
