1 AN ACT to Amend the Implementation of the
2 International Registration Plan under the Motor
3 Vehicle Laws.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2243-A, first ¶, as amended by
8 PL 1985, c. 735, §4, is further amended to read:

9 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Title
10 tle, the Secretary of State, in concurrence with the
11 Commissioner of Transportation, is authorized to enter
12 into reciprocal agreements or plans on behalf of
13 the State of Maine with the appropriate authorities
14 of any of the states of the United States, the Dis-
15 trict of Columbia or any state or province of any
16 country providing for the registration of vehicles on

1 any apportionment or allocation basis and may, in the
2 exercise of this authority, enter into and become a
3 member of the International Registration Plan with an
4 entry date of ~~January 17, 1989~~ January 1, 1990.

5 Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §2243-A, sub-§3, as enacted by
6 PL 1985, c. 735, §4, is amended to read:

7 3. Registration transition. The annual registra-
8 tion of motor vehicles that are to be registered
9 under the International Registration Plan become void
10 on ~~January 17, 1988~~ January 1, 1989, and the annual
11 registration fees for these vehicles shall be pro-
12 rated on a monthly basis and be rounded off to the
13 nearest 1/4 of a dollar.

14 Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall become
15 effective on January 1, 1989, provided that Maine's
16 application to join the International Registration
17 Plan is approved.

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The purpose of this bill is to delay the imple-
20 mentation of the International Registration Plan for
21 one year.
