Notwithstanding any other provision of law, actions taken by the voters of the Town of Trenton on July 8, 1986, and November 4, 1986, relative to an addition to the Trenton Elementary School are hereby declared to be valid for all purposes, despite any errors or omissions in those proceedings.
19 20 21	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
