STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Enforcement of Accessibility Standards for Places of Public Accommodations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSA §4594-B is enacted to read:

§4594-B. Public accommodations constructed, remodeled or enlarged after January 1, 1988

1. Facilities attested. This section applies to any building or facility constructed specifically as a place of public accommodation on or after January 1, 1988, or when the estimated total costs for remodeling or enlarging an existing building exceeds \$100,000 and the remodeling or enlarging is begun after January 1, 1988.

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1	2. Application. Facilities subject to this sec-
2	tion shall meet the following standards.
3	A. Facilities subject to this section con-
4	structed on or after January 1, 1988, shall meet
5	the requirements of the 1986 standards of con-
6	struction adopted pursuant to Title 25, chapter
7	331.
8	B. Plans to reconstruct, remodel or enlarge an
9	existing place of public accommodation, when the
10	estimated total cost exceeds \$100,000, shall be
11	subject to this section when the proposed recon-
12	struction, remodeling or enlargement will sub-
13	stantially affect that portion of the building
14	normally accessible to the public.
15	Facilities subject to this section which are
16	remodeled, enlarged or renovated on or after Jan-
17	uary 1, 1988, shall meet the requirements of the
18	following 4 parts of the 1986 standards of con-
19	struction adopted pursuant to Title 25, chapter
20	331:
21	(1) 4.3 accessible route;
22	(2) 4.3 doors;
23	(3) 4.17 toilet stalls; and
24	(4) 4.29.3 tactile warning on doors to haz-
25	ardous areas.
26	3. Enforcement; inspection. The state, county
27	or municipal authority who reviews plans for any
28	building covered under this section shall:
29	A. Not approve the construction or the opening
30	of such a building if plans or the construction
31	are not in compliance with this section; and
32	B. Require on-site inspections which are deemed
33	necessary to assure compliance with the specific
34	standards of construction set forth in this sec-
35	tion.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill has 3 purposes. First, it makes build-3 ings or facilities construction as places of public 4 accommodation on or after January 1, 1988, subject to 5 the new 1986 standards of construction adopted pursu-6 to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 25, chapter ant 7 331. Second, it makes existing places of public ac-8 commodation which are reconstructed, remodeled or en-9 larged on or after January 1, 1988, at a cost in ex-10 cess of \$100,000, subject to 4 specific parts of the 11 new 1986 standards of construction adopted pursuant 12 to Title 25, chapter 331. Third, it prohibits state, 13 county or municipal officials responsible for approv-14 ing building plans, from approving construction of 15 permitting the opening of a building subject to the 16 section, if the plans or construction are not in com-17 pliance with the requirements of the sections.

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
