STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill provides funding for energy programs, product shows, demonstration equipment, informational 3 materials and conferences to inform Maine businesses 4 5 the increasing potential of energy refficient products and technologies to reduce their energy bills. The money for this program will come from the 6 7 .8 Stripper Well Overcharge Funds. The State has re-9 ceived over \$5,000,000 in these funds, which are to 10 be used to provide restitution to overcharged oil 11 consumers through state energy conservation programs.

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
