STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill provides funding for energy programs,
 3 product shows, demonstration equipment, informational
 4 materials and conferences to inform Maine businesses
 5 of the increasing potential of energy efficient
 6 products and technologies to reduce their energy
 7 bills. The money for this program will come from the
 8 Stripper Well Overcharge Funds. The State has re-
 9 ceived over \$5,000,000 in these funds, which are to
 10 be used to provide restitution to overcharged oil
 11 consumers through state energy conservation programs.

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
