STATEMENT OF FACT

10 The Aroostook Band of Micmacs, the Central Maine Indian Association, the Houlton Band the Passamaquoddy Tribe at Indian 11 of Maliseets, 12 Township, the 13 Passamaquoddy Tribe at Pleasant Point and the 14 Penobscot Indian Nation are requesting this appropri-15 ation for an all-Indian consolidated approach in pre-16 vention, education and treatment services for sub-17 stance abuse.

18 A large portion of the funds being requested are 19 for several inter-tribal Native American Youth Con-20 ferences for Native American Youth, ages 8 to 16, who 21 are subject to high risk of alcohol and drug abuse.
