SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
S.P. 116, L.D. 289, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Questions
Put to the Electorate at Referendum."

Amend the amendment by inserting before the last
paragraph the following:

Further amend the bill by striking out all of
section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Application. Notwithstanding any other
laws, this Act shall apply to all pending ballot questions
that have not been voted on by the people on the effective
date of this Act.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear that
the provisions of this bill to correct misleading ballot
questions will apply to all referendums after its effective
date.
