SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 116, L.D. 289,  
8 Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Questions Put to the Elec-

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2  
11 and inserting in its place the following:

12

'Sec. 2. Application. Notwithstanding any other  
13 laws, this Act shall apply to all pending ballot  
14 questions that have not been voted on by the people  
15 on the effective date of this Act.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear  
18 that the provisions of the bill to correct misleading  
19 ballot questions will apply to all referenda after  
20 its effective date.
