COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 236, L.D. 304,
Bill, " AN ACT to Reduce the Incidence of Motor Vehi-
cle Accidents among Maine's Young Drivers."

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 29 MRSA §585-A is enacted to read:

§585-A. Period of time required before minors apply
for licenses

The Secretary of State shall not accept the ap-
plication of any minor for an operator's license un-
less that minor has held a valid instruction permit
for a period of at least 3 months prior to making ap-
plication for a road test examination.

The Secretary of State may waive the 3-month
waiting period if the applicant has proof there is no
other means of transportation to and from school or
for work purposes. Such proof shall include a state-
ment of the need in writing from a school administra-
tion or employer.'
