5. Implementation of recommendations. To the extent possible in the absence of additional statutory authority, the department shall proceed to implement the recommendation set forth in the reports required by Public Law 1985, chapter 738, section 2, regarding recruitment, training and staffing levels for certified nursing assistants.
