1 AN ACT to Require the Department of Human
2 Services to Implement Certain
3 Recommendations Regarding the
4 Recruitment, Training and Staffing
5 Levels for Certified Nursing
6 Assistants.

8 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
9 follows:

10 22 MRSA §1812-C, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

11 5. Implementation of recommendations. To the
12 extent possible in the absence of additional statuto-
13 ry authority, the department shall proceed to imple-
14 ment the recommendation set forth in the reports re-
15 quired by Public Law 1985, chapter 738, section 2,
16 regarding recruitment, training and staffing levels
17 for certified nursing assistants.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill requires the Department of Human Ser-
3 vices to implement certain recommendations regarding
4 the recruitment, training and staffing levels for
5 certified nursing assistants. The 112th Legislature
6 required the Department of Human Services to prepare
7 2 reports setting forth various data and analyses and
8 make specific recommendations.

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
