1 AN ACT to Extend the Sunset Date for Certain  
2 Statutes Regarding Harbor Masters.

4 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
5 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
6 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

7 Whereas, certain changes in the laws governing  
8 the authority of harbor masters are to be repealed on  
9 April 1, 1987, pursuant to Public Law 1985, chapter  
10 692, section 4; and

11 Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as  
12 emergency legislation it will not take effect before  
13 the repeal takes effect thus causing great confusion  
14 and difficulty in enforcement of those laws; and
