SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 249, L.D. 322, Bill, "AN ACT to Allow Reasonable Attorneys Fees for Court Appointed Counsel on Appeals by the State to any Federal Court."

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill in subsection 9, in the 7th line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words: "Department of the Attorney General" and inserting in their place the following: 'Judicial Department'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment allows reasonable attorneys fees to be paid from the Judicial Department's account to court appointed counsel when the State appeals a decision to any Federal Court. It also removes the appropriation, since funding is provided in the Part II budget.
