Amend the bill in the first paragraph after the  
amending clause in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1,  
lines 13 and 14 in L.D.) by striking out the follow-  
ing: "a private security guard, as licensed pursuant  
to" and inserting in its place the following: "if  
permitted under local regulation or ordinance, a pri-  
ate security guard licensed under"

This amendment clarifies that licensed private  
security guards may be on duty, instead of police of-  
ficers, at dances where minors are admitted only if  
the local regulations or ordinances permit it.
