Relating to Continued Group Health Insurance Coverage.

9 Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §2809-A, sub-§11, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 684, §2, is repealed.

2	The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provi-
3	sions requiring continued group health insurance cov-
4	erage. Currently, both federal law and state law re-
5	quire such continuation. The 2 laws, though similar,
6	are not equivalent and have conflicting requirements.

Repeal of the state provisions will reduce confusion and eliminate conflicting requirements, while still providing for continued coverage in a group health insurance plan.

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
