AN ACT to Repeal Certain Statutes  
Relating to Continued Group Health  
Insurance Coverage.

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5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2330, sub-§11, as enacted by PL  
8 1985, c. 684, §1, is repealed.

9 Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §2809-A, sub-§11, as enacted  
10 by PL 1985, c. 684, §2, is repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to repeal the provisions requiring continued group health insurance coverage. Currently, both federal law and state law require such continuation. The 2 laws, though similar, are not equivalent and have conflicting requirements.

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Repeal of the state provisions will reduce confusion and eliminate conflicting requirements, while still providing for continued coverage in a group health insurance plan.

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
