Services.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. Bagaduce Music Lending Library. The
7 Bagaduce Music Lending Library in Blue Hill shall
8 freely loan and, without charge, make available to
9 all Maine citizens its collection of vocal and in-
10 strumental music.

11 The loaning of materials shall also be available,
12 free of charge, for interlibrary loans to all public
13 and academic libraries in Maine.

14 The facilities shall be available for use by the
15 public without fee.

1 Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
2 appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
3 purposes of this Act.
