AN ACT in Support of Statewide Music Lending Services.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. Bagaduce Music Lending Library. The Bagaduce Music Lending Library in Blue Hill shall freely loan and, without charge, make available to all Maine citizens its collection of vocal and instrumental music.
The loaning of materials shall also be available, free of charge, for interlibrary loans to all public and academic libraries in Maine.
