1 2 3	AN ACT to Amend the Laws Concerning the State Employee Health Insurance Coverage.
4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
6 7	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§1, ¶E, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 692, §1, is amended to read:
8 9 10	E. Any employee of Council 74 93 of the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees;
11 12 13	Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §285, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1985, c. 785, Pt. A, §30, is further amended to read:

1 Coverage. Each state employee to whom this 2 applies shall be eligible for group accident section 3 and sickness or health insurance as provided in Title 4 24-A, sections 2802 to 2812, including major medical 5 benefits. The provisions of such group insurance 6 policy or policies shall be determined, insofar 7 such provisions are not inconsistent with terms and 8 conditions contained in collective bargaining 9 ments negotiated pursuant to Title 26, chapter 9-B, by a board of trustees consisting of 5 6 members, 10 of whom shall be appointed by the employee organiza-11 tion certified to represent the majority of 12 13 one of whom shall be appointed by the employee organization certified to represent the 2nd largest 14 number of employees; one of whom shall be a retired 15 state employee selected by a majority vote of the 16 17 Presidents of the Chapters of the Retired State Em-18 ployees Association; and 2 state employees who 19 appointed by the Governor. The board of trustees, 20 as authorized by chapter 379, shall hold office for 3 21 years, with initial appointments to be made as 22 One member appointed by the Governor for 3 years and one member appointed by the Governor for 2 23 years; one member appointed by the Maine State Em-24 25 ployees Association for 3 years and one member 26 pointed by the Maine State Employees Association for 27 2 years; one member, appointed by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees for 28 and one member, appointed by the Maine State 29 years; Retirees, for one year. The master policy for 30 31 group insurance shall be held by the Commissioner of 32 Administration who shall be ex officio a member the board of trustees. Said The group insurance shall 33
