4 5	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:		
6 7	20-A MRSA §5201, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:		
8 9 10	2. <u>Minimum ages.</u> The following are minimum ages necessary for student enrollment in a school administrative unit.		
11 12 13	A. A person who will be at least 6 years old on Getober 15th July 15th of the school year may enroll in grade one.		

B. A person who will be at least 5 years old on
Oetober 15th July 15th of the school year may en-
roll in a one-year kindergarten if it is offered.
C. A person who will be at least 4 years old on
October 15th July 15th of the school year may en-
roll in a 2-year childhood education program pri-
or to grade one if it is offered.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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9 The purpose of this bill is to adjust the date by 10 which minimum age for entry into kindergarten and 11 first grade is determined from October 15th to July 15th.

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
