1 AN ACT to Allow a County Treasurer to Appoint.
2 a Deputy Treasurer.
3

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 30 MRSA §651, as amended by PL 1981, c. 394, §3,
7 is further amended to read:

8 §651. Appointment; duties

9 The treasurers of the several counties may ap-
10 point deputy treasurers, subject to the requirements
11 of section 64-A, for their respective counties. Such
12 deputy treasurer shall assist the treasurer in per-
13 forming the duties of his office. He shall give bond
14 to the county for the faithful discharge of his du-
15 ties in such sum as the county commissioners order

1 and with such sureties as they approve in writing
2 thereon, the premium of such bond to be met by the
3 county. The deputy treasurer shall act as treasurer
4 in the event of a vacancy until a treasurer is chosen
5 in accordance with section 601.

6 STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to permit county
8 treasurers to appoint deputy treasurers without the
9 approval of the county commissioners.

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
