AN ACT to Allow a County Treasurer to Appoint a Deputy Treasurer.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

30 MRSA §651, as amended by PL 1981, c. 394, §3, is further amended to read:

8 §651. Appointment; duties

9 The treasurers of the several counties may ap-10 point deputy treasurers, subject to the requirements 11 ef section 64-A, for their respective counties. Such 12 deputy treasurer shall assist the treasurer in per-13 forming the duties of his office. He shall give bond 14 to the county for the faithful discharge of his du-15 ties in such sum as the county commissioners order

and with such sureties as they approve in writing thereon, the premium of such bond to be met by the county. The deputy treasurer shall act as treasurer in the event of a vacancy until a treasurer is chosen in accordance with section 601.

STATEMENT OF FACT

7 The purpose of this bill is to permit county 8 treasurers to appoint deputy treasurers without the 9 approval of the county commissioners.
