4 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-5 lature do not become effective until 90 days after 6 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

7 Whereas, the 9-1-1 study commission established 8 in Private and Special Law 1985, chapter 114, is 9 still continuing its work; and

10 Whereas, the reporting deadline and the dissolu-11 tion of the commission will occur before its work is 12 completed unless this legislation is enacted as emer-13 gency legislation; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

- 7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:
- 9 Sec. 1. P&SL 1985, c. 114, §2, last sentence is 10 amended to read:
- 11 The commission shall be dissolved March 1 June 30, 12 1987.
- 13 Sec. 2. P&SL 1985, c. 114, §3 is amended to 14 read:

15 Sec. 3. Report. The 9-1-1 study commission 16 shall report to the Legislature by January 1 March 17 <u>31</u>, 1987, on the feasibility and desirability of a 18 mandatory 9-1-1 in the heavily populated areas of the 19 State.

20 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 21 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-22 proved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill extends the reporting deadline and the
life of the 9-1-1 study commission as established in
Private and Special Law 1985, chapter 114.
