1 AN ACT Pertaining to a Training Season for  
2 Bear Dogs.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
5 follows:

6 12 MRSA §7861, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1979, c.  
7 420, §1, is amended to read:

8 1. Open training season. Except as provided for  
9 in section 7331, it is lawful to train dogs on foxes,  
10 rabbits and raccoons from August 1st through the fol-  
11 lowing April 30th. It is lawful to train dogs on  
12 bear from August 1st to August 31st.
