1 AN ACT to Provide for a Replacement Moose
2 Permit when Infected Animals are
3 Taken.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§10-A is enacted to read:

8 10-A. Replacement permit. If, at the time a
9 moose is presented for inspection at a registration
10 station, a state biologist finds the moose to be in-
11 fected with Taenia Krabbei, Cysticercus Tarandi or
12 muscle cysticercosis, to the point where it is gener-
13 ally not usable for human consumption as determined
14 by the person inspecting the moose, then, upon appli-
15 cation, the commissioner shall issue a replacement
16 permit allowing the permittee to take an additional

1 moose. Any moose carcass determined to be so infected
2 shall become the property of the State.

3 STATEMENT OF FACT

4 This bill allows a moose permittee to procure a
5 permit for an additional moose if the moose he
6 presents for inspection is found to be infected to
7 the point of being unusable for human consumption.

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
