## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 144, L.D. 398

## 1 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment removes the 2 restrictions on payments to jurors that were included in the bill. It deletes the provision that restricted reimbursement for parking fees to a maximum of \$5. It also deletes the provision that restricted a juror's pay to \$10 if the juror was excused from service or his service was postponed. Under this amendment, a juror will receive reimbursement for his full actual and necessary substantiated parking expenses and will receive his full \$20 pay for jury service even if the juror is excused or his service is delayed.
