STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Require Greater Specificity in the Annual Reports of the Maine Health Care Finance Commission.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 6 follows:

22 MRSA §388, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 778, §1, is amended to read:

B. The commission shall prepare a report of the annual savings to the payors as a result of this chapter and shall submit this report annually to the Bureau of Insurance. The Bureau of Insurance shall take this savings into account in approving health insurance rates. A copy of this report shall be submitted to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resources. The report shall include:

(1) Data citations, to the extent possible, to support the factual statements in the report;

(2) To the extent possible, the administrative requirements for compliance with the system by hospitals;

(3) The commission's view of the likely future impact on the health care financing system of trends in the use or financing of hospital care, including federal reimbursement policies, demographic changes, technological advances and competition from other providers;

- 14(4) The commission's view of likely changes15in apportionment of revenues among classes16of payors and purchasers as a result of17trends set out in subparagraph (3);
- 18(5) The relationship of the advisory com-19mittees to the commission;
- 20(6) Comparisons of the impact of the hospi-21tal care financing system with relevant re-22gional and national data, to the extent that23such data is available; and
- 24(7) To the extent available, information on25trends in utilization.
