1 AN ACT to Authorize Issuance of Special
2 License Plates for use by Active
3 Members of the Maine National Guard.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 29 MRSA §252-F is enacted to read:

8 §252-F. Maine National Guard, special license plates

9 On the application of an active member of the
10 Maine Army or Air National Guard whose active status
11 is certified by the Adjutant General and the payment
12 of the excise tax required by Title 36, section 1482,
13 the Secretary of State shall issue a registration
14 certificate and a set of special designated plates,
15 to be used in lieu of regular plates to designate the

1 vehicle as belonging to an active member of the Maine
2 Army or Air National Guard. The Secretary of State
3 may design these special plates which shall carry the
4 word "Maine" across the top, a minuteman logo on the
5 left, numerals in the center and the words "National
6 Guard" across the bottom. The special registration
7 plates for members of the Maine Army or Air National
8 Guard may be used only on one motor vehicle whose
9 registered gross weight shall not exceed 9,000
10 pounds.

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 The purpose of this legislation is to authorize
13 the issuance and purchase of distinctive license
14 plates to active members of the Maine Army and Air
15 National Guard for use on their personal vehicles.
16 These distinctive plates will help identify and to
17 facilitate movement in case of emergency and to en-
18 hance recruiting and retention programs within the
19 Maine National Guard.
