The purpose of this legislation is to authorize the issuance and purchase of distinctive license plates to active members of the Maine Army and Air National Guard for use on their personal vehicles. These distinctive plates will help identify and to facilitate movement in case of emergency and to enhance recruiting and retention programs within the Maine National Guard.
