There is also some question as to acceptance of these changes by the Federal Government. A ruling against the proposed changes would seriously jeopardize current Medicaid funding. If the ruling is favorable, the exact amount and the direction of the impact cannot be determined until the number of current married recipients and their net worth is determined and the number of new applicants that would

be eligible under these proposed guidelines is estimated. Due to the effective date of the bill, any impact would primarly affect fiscal year 1989 fund-

ing.'
