16	STATEMENT OF FACT
17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31	This amendment adds an effective date clause which will make this Act effective March 1, 1988. In addition, the amendment sunsets the Act on March 1, 1988. The purpose of this amendment is to enact the bill with a delayed effective date and an immediate sunset repeal. The delayed effective date will allow time for Congress to take federal action on providing equity in calculating the availability of income for institutionalized care under Medicaid. Federal initiatives are currently before the Congress. The sunset provision requires further legislative action, that is, repeal of the sunset provision, for the state law to take effect. Due to the fact that the bill will not become effective, this amendment removes the necessity of placing a fiscal note on the bill.

The sunset provision is being enacted now to let Congress know that Maine is serious about correcting this inequity regardless of federal action. In addi-

tion, a joint resolution has been introduced memorializing Congress to take action.
