1 AN ACT Requiring the Issuance of Doe
2 Hunting Permits to Persons who are
3 Eligible for Free Hunting Licenses.

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶I is enacted to read;

8 I. For any hunting season where an antlerless
9 deer permit system is in effect, the commissioner
10 shall issue, without fee, a permit to hunt
11 antlerless deer as provided in the permit system
12 to any person who is eligible for a hunting li-
13 cense without paying a fee.
