12 MRSA §7457, sub-§1, ¶I is enacted to read;

I. For any hunting season where an antlerless deer permit system is in effect, the commissioner shall issue, without fee, a permit to hunt antlerless deer as provided in the permit system to any person who is eligible for a hunting license without paying a fee.
