5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as

7 Sec. 1. 28 MRSA §4, first ¶, as repealed and re-
8 placed by PL 1975, c. 741, §2, is amended to read:

9 No liquor ~~shall~~ may be sold except as ~~herein~~ pro-
10 vided in this section. Liquor for on premise
11 consumption may be sold and delivered by any licensee
12 by himself, clerk, servant or agent between 6 a.m.
13 and 1 a.m. Malt liquor table wines for consumption
14 off the premises may be sold and delivered by any li-
15 censee by himself, clerk, servant or agent between 6
16 a.m. and 9 p.m.
