1 2 3 4	AN ACT to Amend the Divorce Laws Regarding Custody to the Department of Human Services.	
5 6	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine follows:	as

7 19 MRSA §752, sub-§9, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 8 813, §5, is repealed and the following enacted in its 9 place:

9. Department of Human Services. When the Department of Human Services has been granted parental rights and responsibilities for a child under this section, Title 22, chapter 1071, shall apply regarding subsequent reviews and shall govern further rights and responsibilities of the department, the parents, the child and any other party.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The 1983 changes to the Maine Revised Statutes, 3 Title 19, section 752, subsection 6, limited orders 4 of rights and responsibilities to other than a parent 5 to situations in which there is a finding of jeopardy 6 as defined in the child protection laws, specifically 7 Title 22, section 4002, subsection 6.

8 When a child comes into the custody of the de-9 partment under the divorce laws, the department pro-10 vides the same services not only for the child, but 11 also for the parents and other parties, as for other 12 children and families under the whole of Title 22, 13 chapter 1071.

14 This revision in Title 19, section 752, subsec-15 tion 9, clarifies and specifically authorizes those 16 rights and responsibilities.

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
