1 AN ACT Relating to Taking of Shad in Addison  
2 and Columbia Falls.  
3

4 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-  
5 lature do not become effective until 90 days after  
6 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

7 Whereas, in order to conserve the natural re-  
8 sources of the State, it becomes vitally necessary,  
9 from time to time, to regulate certain of the fishing  
10 resources; and

11 Whereas, the run of Atlantic salmon in Pleasant  
12 River occurs June to November each year; and



1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This bill allows the taking of shad during the  
3 month of May in Addison and Columbia Falls by chang-  
4 ing the beginning of the closed season from May 1st  
5 to June 1st.
