6	4-A. Exception. Notwithstanding this section, a
7	licensed shellfish processor or shellfish retailer
8	may possess shellstock in excess of the tolerance in
9	any bulk pile provided that the bulk pile has been
.0	graded by the processor or retailer.

The purpose of this bill is to provide an exemption to any licensed shellfish processor or retailer from the 2-inch clam tolerance provided that the processor or retailer graded the bulk pile.
