AN ACT to Extend the Life of the Advisory Committee on Staff Retention.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. Reporting date; duties. Notwithstanding 7 Public Law 1985, chapter 749, section 2, the Advisory 8 Committee on Staff Retention, as established, by Pub-9 lic Law 1985, chapter 749, shall continue through 1987 and submit its report, together with any recom-10 mendations and legislation in final draft form to the 11 12 Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature. In 13 addition to the duties established under Public Law 14 1985, chapter 749, the committee may expand its scope 15 of review to include other facilities with similar 16 problems.
