AN ACT to Extend the Life of the Advisory
Committee on Staff Retention.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Reporting date; duties. Notwithstanding Public Law 1985, chapter 749, section 2, the Advisory Committee on Staff Retention, as established, by Public Law 1985, chapter 749, shall continue through 1987 and submit its report, together with any recommendations and legislation in final draft form to the Second Regular Session of the 113th Legislature. In addition to the duties established under Public Law 1985, chapter 749, the committee may expand its scope of review to include other facilities with similar problems.
