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STATEMENT OF FACT

6 Group and nursing homes providing residential 7 care for mentally retarded citizens have been hit 8 with substantial increases in insurance costs over 9 These facilities, almost entirely the last year. 10 nonprofit, are dependent on state funding through Principles of Reimbursement promulgated by the Department of Human Services. However, these principles do not provide for those adjustments and include 11 12 13 14 allowances for all insurance costs, without which the homes would be operating under serious jeopardy.

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
