1 AN ACT Making Additional Allocations for the
2 Administrative Expenses of the
3 Department of Finance, Bureau of
4 Lottery, for the Fiscal Year Ending
5 June 30, 1987.

7 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
8 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
9 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

10 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate un-
11 til after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

12 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
13 dent to the operation of the Bureau of Lottery will
14 become due and payable prior to July 1, 1987; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
8 follows:

9 Sec. 1. Allocation of State Lottery Fund. In
10 order to provide for the necessary expenses of opera-
11 tion and administration of the Bureau of Lottery, the
12 following amounts, or as much as may be necessary,
13 are allocated from the revenues derived from opera-
14 tions of the State Lottery Fund.

36 Sec. 2. Allotments required. Upon receipt of
37 allotments duly approved by the Governor based upon

1 work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer,
2 the State Controller shall authorize expenditures
3 from these allocations on the basis of these allot-
4 ments and not otherwise.

5 Sec. 3. Legislative intent. It is the intent of
6 the Legislature that the allocation of funds by the
7 Legislature, as provided by this Act, shall apply to
8 the operating expenses only and that these alloca-
9 tions shall be allotted and approved under the Maine
10 Revised Statutes, Title 5.

11 Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations
12 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-
13 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-
14 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-
15 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-
16 ture and those reclassifications and range changes
17 which have been approved by the Department of Admin-
18 istration and submitted for legislative review prior
19 to the effective date of this Act.

20 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited
21 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-
22 proved.

23 STATEMENT OF FACT

24 This bill makes allocations for the administra-
25 tive expenses of the Bureau of Lottery for the fiscal
26 year ending June 30, 1987.
