4 5 6	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
7 8 9	Whereas, the 90-day period will not terminate until after the next biennial professional license renewal period; and
10 11 12	Whereas, in the absence of this legislation the expenditures of the State Board of Social Worker Registration will exceed their revenues; and
13 14 15	Whereas, a deficit in the board's budget will in- duce obligations for the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation; and

- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
- 7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
 8 follows:
- 9 32 MRSA §7060, first ¶, as last amended by PL 10 1985, c. 736, §19, is further amended to read:
- Licenses shall expire biennially on December 31st or at such other times as the Commissioner of Business, Occupational and Financial Regulation may designate. Biennial fees for renewal
- of license shall be set by the board in an amount not to exceed \$50 \$125 and shall be due and payable biennially on or before the first day of January 1st. Every 2nd renewal shall be contingent upon evidence of participation in a continuing professional education

course or program as approved by the board. A li-

cense may be renewed up to 90 days after the date of expiration upon payment of a late fee of \$10 in addition to the renewal fee. Any person who submits an application for renewal more than 90 days after the renewal date shall be subject to all requirements

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governing new applicants under this chapter, except that the board may in its discretion, giving due consideration to the protection of the public, waive examination if the renewal application is made within 2

years from the date of the expiration.

31 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 32 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-33 proved.

The purpose of this bill is to increase the cur- rent limit of \$50 on the license renewal fees up to the level of the first time license fee of \$125 in an attempt to offset an impending deficit in the budget of the Board of Social Worker Registration.	3 4 5
The proposed bill would increase the dedicated revenue of the State Board of Social Worker Registration by \$38,550 in fiscal year 1987.	8
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
