In order to provide for the necessary expenses of operation and administration of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and the State Liquor Commission, the following amounts, or as much as may be necessary, are allocated from the revenues derived from operations of the Alcoholic Beverage Fund.

Sec. 2. Allotments required. Upon receipt of allotments duly approved by the Governor based upon

35 36 work programs submitted to the State Budget Officer, the State Controller shall authorize expenditures from these allocations on the basis of these allotments and not otherwise.

5 Sec. 3. Legislative intent. It is the intent of 6 the Legislature that the allocation of funds by the 7 Legislature, as provided by this Act, shall apply to the administrative expenses only and that these allo-8 9 cations shall be allotted and approved under the 10 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5. It is not intended affect the use of the working capital, provided 11 12 for by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28 or other 13 activities required of the State Liquor Commission by 14 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 28.

15 Sec. 4. Adjustments to allocations. Allocations 16 may be increased or adjusted by the State Budget Of-17 ficer with the approval of the Governor to specifi-18 cally cover those adjustments determined to be neces-19 sary under any salary plan approved by the Legisla-20 ture, and those reclassifications and range changes which have been approved by the Department of Person-nel, or its successor, and submitted for legislative 21 22 23 review prior to the effective date of this Act.

24 Sec. 5. Exclusion. Exclusive of the provisions of sections 1 to 4, in addition to the amounts autho-25 26 rized by Private and Special Law 1985, chapter 27, up 27 \$52,000 for capital expenditures may be expended 28 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 29 items related to establishment of an additional State 30 Liquor Store in York and for the purchase of modems 31 to connect the new point of sale cash register system 32 to the main frame.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
