1 AN ACT to Allow Special Registration Plates
2 for Persons Formerly Listed as Missing
3 in Action.
4

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 29 MRSA §252-E, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 737,
8 Pt. A, §80, is amended to read:

9 §252-E. Former prisoners of war; and veterans for-
10 merly missing in action; special license
11 plates

12 The Secretary of State, on application and upon
13 evidence of payment of the excise tax required by Ti-
14 tle 36, section 1482, shall issue a registration cer-
15 tificate and set of special designating plates to be

1 used in lieu of regular registration plates to any
2 person who served in the United States Armed Forces
3 and who was a prisoner of war at any time during his
4 tenure of service or who was at any time listed as
5 missing in action, when that application is accompa-
6 nied by a copy of the appropriate military form cer-
7 tifying that the person is a former prisoner of war
8 or was listed as missing in action. This special li-
9 icense plate is issued specifically to former pris-
10 oners of war and the The privilege of using the special
11 plate is not transferable.

12 These special designating plates shall be of a
13 design as determined by the Secretary of State.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this bill is to allow persons who
16 were formerly listed as missing in action to have
17 special license plates as former prisoners of war
18 currently have.
